Proper Email Etiquette From Br. Pete Muceus

I have received complaints from several members at different times about the types of emails being sent with what appears to be a very wide KC distribution list. The most recent complaint included what I consider to be a very good list of email etiquette. Please consider these when sending emails to KC members.

1) When you receive an email from someone who has sent it to the entire KC list, DO NOT use REPLY TO ALL. Please reply only to the chairperson or to who has been designated, not to all. If we do need to hear the results, then the chairperson can summarize all the responses they receive into one follow-up email to us.

2) If you receive a joke or chain mail type email from someone in our list, do not forward it as the sender most likely already has sent it to others when they sent it to you. If you want to comment on it, then do so in a reply to the sender only. Someone doesn't want to get the same joke twenty times, which does happen when you don't follow this point of etiquette. No one needs to hear everyone's individual comment on how funny the joke is, or how pretty the sunset in the picture is, or how much that piece of toast looks like Jesus.

3) DO NOT share people's email addresses through open listing as a "to" addressee. Use BCC to send list emails. When you send open lists, receivers are much more subject to viruses and spam, and further violation of these rules of etiquette.

4) DO NOT set your email to ask for a reply when you send it. Virtually every email system will send you a notice when you send an email that cannot be delivered without you asking for delivery receipt.

5) If you use email lists, check to see if you have multiple email addresses for the same person. While you might have received an email from someone at different times from their personal email address and their work email address, you don't need to have both in your mailing list. To do so simply means the receiver will have to deal with two emails for each item sent since they come in on both email addresses. If, as receiver, I want to receive it on both addresses, then that is fine, but the sender should not carry both addresses unless requested.

6) The KC organization is a Catholic Men's Organization, it is not a political platform to express or promote a personal political agenda. Please keep your political views to other people who believe as you do, not an entire KC distribution list.

The above items are part of most any etiquette list for email, including most companies. Much too often, people send an email to groups without understanding the implication to the receivers of those emails.

Chicago bishop new archbishop for San Antonio

The Most Rev. Gustavo Garcia-Siller, 53, will be the next archbishop of San Antonio, the Vatican's Web site announced today.

He is an auxiliary bishop in the Archdiocese of Chicago where he is the liaison for Hispanic ministry to Cardinal Francis George and also a regional administrator of the largest district within the archdiocese.

Garcia-Siller is a member of the Missionaries of the Holy Spirit, a religious order founded in Mexico City, which he joined in 1973.

He is from the central-Mexican city of San Luis Potosi as the oldest of 15 children and was ordained a priest in 1984.

He served in a variety of ministry positions in California for the religious order before moving to Chicago to be an auxiliary bishop.

By naming him, the Vatican keeps intact the string of Hispanic archbishops started when retired San Antonio archbishop Patrick Flores took the helm in 1979. Archbishop Jose Gomez replaced Flores six years ago and moved in May to head the Los Angeles archdiocese next year.

Described by many as warm, extroverted and enthusiastic, he is scheduled to attend a press conference later today at the Pastoral Center.
